- 7. Where you withdraw or interrupt your studies dng the first term, 25 per cent of the fee will be due for payment irrespective of the date of withdrawal. For withdrawals and interruptions occurring after the Christmas vacation, a-parta charge will be levied on a daily basis.

- 8. Your total tuition fee for 2013/14 will be charged from the date of enrolment. 50 per cent of the fees must be paid by 31 October 2013 and the balance can be paid by instalments. For details, please contact income@d.ac.uk
- 9. Where you withdraw or interrupt your studies during the first term, 50 per cent of the fee will be due for payment irrespective of the date of withdrawal. For withdrawals and interruptions occurring after the Christmas vacation, a-parts charge will be levied on a daily basis.
